2. DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST – None.

3. MINUTES – Approval of minutes of the Parish Council Meeting held on 23rd October 2018. Proposed by Cllr Wigg, seconded by Cllr Mayhew and thus agreed by the Parish Council to accept the Minutes of the last meeting.

4. CLERK'S REPORT AND MATTERS ARISING

- New boundary information received. SCDC Cllr Jones stated that Knodishall will come under Aldeburgh and Leiston, reducing councillors from four to three.
