The two existing councils cover the entire Suffolk coastline (much of which requires protection), and have a shared transport infrastructure (including rail links and the A12), ports, market towns, beach resorts and similar areas of outstanding natural beauty. East Suffolk also enjoys a vibrant cultural life with a number of renowned festivals and events and the area boasts an 'Energy Coast' combining expanding off-shore wind sector and nuclear power.
